

## Remembering Royston



During the Second World War Royston found itself at the centre of a cluster of airfields, including Bassingbourn, Steeple Morden, Fowlmere and Nuthampstead. The exhibition will use first-hand accounts and photographs to explore the experiences of local residents and American 8th USAAF personnel during their time in the area.

The exhibition launches at [Royston Town Museum](#) on Saturday 14th November with a special coffee morning and will be on display until mid-January. The museum is open Wednesday, Thursday & Saturday 10—5 (last entry 4:45). Admission is free although donations are welcome.
